

## QUESTION PROPOSAL

# TEMPLE



### WHAT WE NEED:

- A set of tests for Biology and Chemistry - ballpark quantity 80 + overlap per subject.
- Tests in the correct format.
- High quality questions and coverage of 100% of the specification is a given.
- 9-1 New GCSE format for AQA, OCR and Edexcel specifications.

The QUESTION GUIDE should be followed completely.

### PROCEDURE:

- 1 test made should take on average 40 minutes.
- Tests preferably sent in frequently (at the end of each day).
- Once these tests have been received, they will be forwarded to teachers and heads of subjects at various schools as a method of quality control.
- After they have been approved by these teachers, payments will roll in blocks of 6 tests (£120 to be paid every 6 approved tests).

### DATES:

- We need the tests to be completed by 20/10/2016.
- From then, a final quality control check will be passed, final payments will be sent and the questions will be entered into the coding.

### PAYMENTS:

- Pay is £30 / hour.
- Tests should take 40 minutes.
- This means that pay is £60 per 3 tests.
- As mentioned before, payments will be made in blocks of 6 tests, after passing various quality control checks.
- In regard to the overlap, we will take the mean number of tests across the 3 boards, add 20% and complete the payments for those tests, again assuming they took 40 minutes each.

### ISSUES:

- If a test doesn't pass quality control, or doesn't follow the Question Guide's guidelines, we will ask for the area lacking to be redone.
- If for whatever reason question writing is to be stopped, then all completed unpaid tests that pass the quality control and guidelines will be paid for within the above £30 / hour rate, assuming each test has taken 40 minutes to write.
- If a board or any other body speaks to us about copyright infringement, and it is clear there has been a breaching of copyright, we will ask for the areas in question to be rewritten. Otherwise, we will ask for a return of payment for these areas.
